A. SALE NOTICE

Heffel Gallery Limited (additionally herein referred to as “Heffel” or “Auction House”) is honoured to collaborate with the Vancouver Art Gallery to present a selection of important artworks through our Online Auction Partnership (HO2) platform, from June 1 to 15, 2021.

Founded in 1931, the Vancouver Art Gallery is recognized as one of North America’s most respected and innovative visual arts institutions. The Gallery’s innovative ground-breaking exhibitions, extensive public programs and emphasis on advancing scholarship all focus on the historical and contemporary art of British Columbia and international centres, with special attention to the accomplishments of First Nations artists and the art of the Asia Pacific region. The Vancouver Art Gallery is a not-for-profit organization supported by its members, individual donors, corporate funders, foundations, the City of Vancouver, the Province of British Columbia through the British Columbia Arts Council, and the Canada Council for the Arts.

The artworks included in this sale were donated to the Vancouver Art Gallery by artists and private donors. Consignor Hammer Price proceeds from this auction will support the Vancouver Art Gallery with their goals and initiatives.

The purchase price shall be the Hammer Price plus the Buyer’s Premium calculated at a rate of twenty-five percent (25%) of the Hammer Price of the Lot up to and including \$25,000; plus twenty percent (20%) on the part of the Hammer Price over \$25,000 and up to and including \$5,000,000; plus fifteen percent (15%) on the part of the Hammer Price over \$5,000,000, plus applicable Sales Tax.

B. SPECIAL TERMS OF SALE

1. Description of Lot

- a) All Lots are sold on an “as is” basis. The Auction House provides no warranties with respect to the state of the Lot. The Buyer accepts full responsibility to inspect the property prior to the conclusion of the auction and accepts the property in its actual physical condition and at the location specified.

- b) The Buyer shall be responsible for ascertaining the condition of the Lot and the frame. Additional images, beyond those posted on www.heffel.com, and condition reports will not be provided by Heffel. Frames may have defects and may not be noted on our website.

- b) Interac e-Transfer limited to two e-Transfers per Lot and up to a maximum of \$10,000 per e-Transfer

- c) Online payment by Visa, Mastercard or UnionPay. Online credit card payments are subject to our acceptance and approval and to a maximum of \$25,000. Such credit card payment limits apply to the value of individual transactions for separate Lots

Heffel is a QST registrant (122 679 **** TQ****). QST will be levied on all purchases collected in Quebec and shipped to Quebec.

Following the close of the sale, all works will be picked up from the Vancouver Art Gallery by Denbigh Fine Art Services and brought to their facility.

All purchases must be paid for in-full prior to the works being collected, delivered or shipped. Heffel will confirm with Denbigh once the work has been paid in full in order to be released.
